# II- Presentation of the African Local Government Academy (ALGA) as a response of UCLG-Africa to build an Effective Local Africa

#### The origin....

**ALGA** was created by a Resolution adopted by African L.A. in 2009 during **AFRICITES Summit** in Marrakech (Morocco)



#### Une initiative Marocaine pour un Projet Africain Sommet AFRICITES V - 2009 de Marrakech

A Major Resolution at Morocco's Initiative « Create an African Academy of Local Authorities »

« The promotion of the territorial dimension of development in Africa cannot be fully effective without the support of trained human resources that are involved in implementing it. This is why the African Ministers and Mayors who attended the Marrakech Meeting subcribed to Morocco's Proposal to create a « support centre for the reinforcement of local authorities' managerial and technical capacities ».The goal is to build up, share and spread best experiences and practices in Africa. This recommandation gave rise to the plan to create an African Academy of Local Authorities »

La traduction de cette Recommandation a pris la forme d'un projet de création d'une Académie Africaine des Collectivités Locales ».




